NOTES
(1) Supervision time is not included above. In both years of training, each fellow has one-hour/week of individual psychotherapy supervision and one-hour/week of individual MD/DO supervision.
(2) Fellows are given three weeks (15 weekdays) of vacation each academic year. Vacation may be taken during any month/rotation in either year.
(3) CAPII elective options include: Academic Track, AODA, brain injury/TBI, community psychiatry, consultation liaison, developmental disabilities, dialectical behavioral therapy, eating disorders, inpatient, neuropsychology testing, psychopharmacology, psychotherapy, research, sleep, or telepsychiatry. If an elective is not offered (and with program approval), fellows may create a new elective at a current/new site.
(4) Fellows may participate in an <i>optional</i> "Academic Track" to have one half-day/week of protected academic/scholarly time in a spectrum of lengths determined by their individual needs/goals – e.g. for both CAPI and CAPII years, CAPI or CAPII year, or 4 month CAPII elective. The program is approved for 1.2 FTE months of Academic Track time per CAPI and CAPII training year (i.e. 2.4 FTE months maximum per academic year). Since this Academic Track is optional and timing/scheduling is tailored to individual fellow's needs/goals, this time is not reflected above.
